
## **UNIVERSITY LIBRARY**

University Library of the Central University of Kerala is the Knowledge Resource Center with the largest collection of learning resources on Arts, Humanities, Science and Social Sciences. The library supports research and educational endeavours of Students, Research Scholars, and the Faculties of the university by collecting, organizing, preserving and disseminating information and provides instructional programs in all formats through need-based services and enables access to online information resources using modern Information & Communication Technologies.

The library started functioning in October 2009 at the Vidyanagar campus, as a centre of information for the academic community. There were five campuses of libraries functioning at Vidyanagar, Periye (main campus), Padanekkad, Thriruvalla and Thiruvananthapuram (Capital Centre). In 2018 Vidyanagar, Periye and Padanekkad campuses merged, and Central University Library started functioning at Periye (Main campus). Within a short period, the library attained a considerable level of development. The library has an appealing ambience and is user-friendly, and is automated with a Wi-Fi network.








# LIBRARY COLLECTION





### **AUTOMATED SOFTWARE IN UNIVERSITY LIBRARY**

### 1.INTEGRATED LIBRARY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (ILMS)

The library is automated with KOHA Open Source Integrated Library Management System (ILMS). The library is using Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) system to organize the knowledge collection. The library is having a good collection of documents on all subjects and a total collection of books is around 58,157 and 632 special Braille collections. Library time is 9.30 am to 10.00 pm. All the students, faculty members and staff are a member of the University Library. University Library has membership in the e-ShodhSindhu consortium and accesses 15,000+ e- journals from them. University Library is individually subscribing to both Indian and foreign journals. The library is regularly updating the new arrivals of books and journal issues to the students and faculty members. Regular Orientation Programmes are given to the library members.



# 2.DIGITAL LIBRARY : INSTITUTIONAL REPOSITORY & RFID TECHNOLOGY

University Library, Central University of Kerala will be officially creating and maintaining the digital repository. The aim of creating such an exclusive digital repository of CUK is to preserve and provide seamless access to the research and scientific output, in-house publications, audio-video materials about CUK or any other relevant item of interest to CUK. Further, this digital repository aims to collect, collate, preserve and disseminate the current research papers of CU Kerala in digital format to enhance the visibility of scholarly publications of the faculty and students without any geographical barriers. This repository enables the deposition of preprints, post-prints of peer-reviewed journal publications, conference proceedings, technical reports, etc using a web interface. Annual reports, Newspaper clippings, Previous years' question papers of CUCET, circulars, Photographs, Audio-Video materials etc. The interface of the portal will be in English, Access will be provided through Intranet and the resources can be freely downloaded for purposes of academic teaching and research with a restriction to download full text wherever applicable. In such cases, the bibliographic information of the particular resource will only be available freely. Redistribution or hosting of full-text content in any other retrieval system for profit is strictly prohibited.

### 3. INFED: REMOTE ACCESS



INDIAN Access Management Federation (INFED), the first Federation in India, has adopted Shibboleth, a standard-based open source software, for authenticating authorized users from colleges and universities and provide them seamless access to e-resources from anywhere, anytime.



# 4. MYLOFT: REMOTE ACCESS

CUK library gives an INFED facility to users for the remote access of e resources which includes 19 publishers and various resources. University library subscribes more than 30 publisher's resources which is not intergraded with INFEED due to the lack of shiboolath facility for few facility. In this regard users are facing problem in identifying the interested resources. Hence CUK migrated towards the MyLOFT which enables the scattered resources in the single platform. Currently CUK subscribes more than 15,000 + e journals and 1100 ebooks 13 databases which has connected with MyLOFT software CUK library has inaugurated and launched the MyLOFT Facility by Prof. H Venkatesharavalu Vice chancellor on 21 st sep 2021 and given 1at level orientation and training program on 22nd sep 2021. More 300 users including teachers research scholars and students participated in the program. Upcoming training programmes will be continued on the next academic year. Users are very much satisfied with the facility during the COVID 19 pandemic situation.
